History and Program

Jode Eye and Marie McClung, created Clothes To Kids out of a passion for helping children in need. The co-founders incorporated and started collecting clothing in 2002. Their idea was to create a cheerful store environment where families and children would be treated with dignity and respect and receive school clothing free of charge.

On June 11, 2003, the first Clothes To Kids store opened in Dunedin. They outgrew the space quickly and moved to the current Clearwater location in 2005. The new 3,700 square foot store was made possible with generous donations from individuals and businesses in the community. The store is set up with a department store look and feel. Children are provided a week's worth of clothing, including 5 pairs of new underwear and socks, 5 tops, 4 bottoms, 1 pair of shoes, 1 coat (in season), and 1 dress (optional), all free of charge.

In December 2009, a second Clothes To Kids store opened in St. Petersburg, which made clothing more accessible to our shoppers in South Pinellas. In July 2018, the first Hillsborough County store opened in Tampa off Hillsborough Avenue. Clothes To Kids to date has provided more than 170,000 wardrobes to kids throughout Tampa Bay.

Mission, Vision and Values

To provide new and quality used clothing to low-income or in crisis school-age children, free of charge.

Volunteer Opportunities

At Clothes To Kids we are committed to matching your talents and interests to a volunteer job that you will enjoy and find fulfilling. Volunteers have specific duties assigned to them and are asked to work with the Clothes To Kids staff to complete their tasks. All volunteers are asked to complete a volunteer application before volunteering. Because our adult volunteers often work closely with children, all prospective adult volunteers must pass a background check.

In Store Opportunities

Store volunteers provide direct services at regularly scheduled hours at the Clothes To Kids stores. Opportunities include working with clients and working in the stockroom to help the store run efficiently.

Examples of volunteer duties include:

- Sorting, tagging, restocking clothes
- Administrative support

- Spanish Interpreting

- Shopper check in and out

- Cleaning store and updating displays - Greeting and assisting shoppers



Off Site Volunteers
